### 2 Getting Started

We recommend that you:

- Unpack the equipment carefully and save the original box and packaging materials for possible future shipment

- Use Kramer high performance high resolution cables<sup>3</sup>



### 3 Overview

The Kramer TOOLS **VP-200NK**, **VP-300NK** and **VP-400NK** are 1:2, 1:3 and 1:4 (respectively) distribution amplifiers for XGA and higher resolution signals with a unique new feature. They include the Kramer innovative integrated sync processing; KR - ISP<sup>TM</sup> technology, which lets you achieve a sharp, stable image when the sync level is too low, by restoring the sync signal waveform.

The VP-200NK, VP-300NK and VP-400NK accept one input, provide correct buffering and isolation, and then distribute the signal to two, three or four (respectively) identical outputs on high-density 15 pin HD connectors.

In particular, the *High Resolution XGA DA*:

- Has a high video bandwidth exceeding 430MHz, ensuring that it remains transparent even at high-resolution graphics modes such as UXGA (1600x1200)
- Includes ID Bit control
- Is 12VDC fed

Achieving the best performance means:

- Connecting only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoiding interference from neighboring electrical appliances and positioning your VP-200NK, VP-300NK and VP-400NK away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust



Caution – No operator-serviceable parts inside unit.

Warning – Use only the Kramer Electronics input power wall adapter that is provided with this unit<sup>1</sup>.

Warning – Disconnect power and unplug unit from wall before installing or removing device or servicing unit.




Figure 1: VP-200NK 1:2 High Resolution XGA DA




Figure 2: VP-200NK (Top Side Panel)




Figure 3: VP-200NK (Lower Side Panel)




Figure 4: VP-300NK 1:3 High Resolution XGA DA




Figure 5: VP-300NK (Top Side Panel)




Figure 6: VP-300NK (Lower Side Panel)




Figure 7: VP-400NK 1:4 High Resolution XGA DA




Figure 8: VP-400NK (Top Side Panel)




Figure 9: VP-400NK (Lower Side Panel)

#### 4.4 The Machine Underside




Figure 10: High Resolution XGA DA (Underside)

#	Feature	Function	
1	Hs Switch	Slide the switch to the right (NORMAL <sup>2</sup> ) to retain the polarity; slide the switch to the left to change the Hs polarity to KR-ISP	
2	ID Bit Switch	Slide to the left to set to ON <sup>3</sup> ; to the right to set to OFF	
3	Vs Switch	Slide the switch up (NORMAL <sup>2</sup> ) to retain the polarity; slide the switch down to change the Vs polarity to KR-ISP

## 5 Connecting the VP-300NK 1:3 High Resolution XGA DA




Figure 11: Connecting the VP-300NK 1:3 High Resolution XGA DA

To connect your **VP-300NK** 1:3 High Resolution XGA DA<sup>1</sup>, as the example in Figure 11 illustrates, do the following<sup>2</sup>:

- 1. Connect a computer graphics source to the INPUT HD15F connector.
- Connect the OUTPUT HD15F connectors to up to three<sup>3</sup> acceptors, as follows:
  - Connect the OUTPUT 1 connector to acceptor 1 (for example, a projector)
  - Connect the OUTPUT 2 connector to acceptor 2 (for example, an LCD monitor)
  - Connect the OUTPUT 3 connector to acceptor 3 (for example, a display)
- 3. Connect the 12V DC power adapter (wall transformer) to the 12V DC socket and connect the transformer to the mains electricity.
- 4. If required, set the:
  - Hs and Vs switches
  - ID Bit switch to ON
