

## 3 Overview

The high quality Kramer **VS-21HDCP** is an HDCP (High-Bandwidth Digital Content Protection)<sup>1</sup> compatible 2x1 *DVI Switcher* that accepts two DVI inputs—letting you select either DVI<sup>2</sup> input using a switch located on the front panel—and routes the selected DVI input signal to the DVI output.

## 3.1 About HDCP

The High-Bandwidth Digital Content Protection (HDCP) standard (developed by Intel), protects digital video and audio signals transmitted over DVI or HDMI connections between two HDCP-enabled devices to eliminate the reproduction of copyrighted material. To protect copyright holders (such as movie studios) from having their programs copied and shared, the HDCP standard provides for the secure and encrypted transmission of digital signals.

### 3.2 Recommendations for Best Performance

Achieving the best performance means:

- Connecting only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoiding interference from neighboring electrical appliances and positioning your VS-21HDCP away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust



Caution – No operator-serviceable parts inside unit.

**Warning** – Use only the Kramer Electronics input power wall adapter that is provided with this unit<sup>3</sup>.

Warning – Disconnect power and unplug unit from wall before installing or removing device or servicing unit.






Figure 2: VS-21HDCP (Top Side Panel)




Figure 3: VS-21HDCP (Lower Side Panel)

1	12V DC	+12V DC connector for powering the unit
2	INPUT 1 DVI Connector	Connect to the DVI source 1
3	INPUT 2 DVI Connector	Connect to the DVI source 2
4	OUTPUT DVI Connector	Connect to the DVI acceptor
5	IN 1 LED	Lights when input 1 is selected
6	IN 2 LED	Lights when input 2 is selected
7	ON LED	Lights when receiving power
8	SELECT Switch	Press to toggle between selec ing input 1 and input 2

# 5 Connecting a VS-21HDCP 2x1 DVI Switcher




Figure 4: Connecting a VS-21HDCP 2x1 DVI Switcher

To connect the **VS-21HDCP** 2x1 DVI Switcher, as illustrated in the example in Figure 4, do the following<sup>1</sup>:

- 1. Connect up to 2 DVI sources to the INPUT connectors, as follows:
- INPUT 1 connector to DVI source 1 (for example, a computer)
- INPUT 2 connector to DVI source 2 (for example, a set top box)
- 2. Connect the OUTPUT connector to the DVI acceptor (for example, a display).
- 3. Connect the 12V DC power adapter (wall transformer) to the 12V DC socket and connect the transformer to the mains electricity.
